# TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY TO PROCESSION

## **ORGANISERS OF FLOATS ARE REQUIRED TO NOTE, ACCEPT AND ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING;**

1. There will be road closures in place to ensure the safety of all participating in the procession. Carnival stewards will maintain these closures. (5.30 - 8.00 pm)  
Reflective jackets or Carnival uniform will easily identify the stewards or officials - please follow any instructions given by any of these officers.
2. When in motion, **DO NOT** attempt to get on or off the vehicles.
3. Children must be supervised at all times when travelling on or near moving vehicles
4. Please ensure participants in your group follow ANY instruction/advice provided by the stewards or officials when the procession is underway.
5. Each float must provide one wheel marshal for each wheel of the vehicle and a nominated representative\* as a point of contact and to ensure that all conditions are met and is accountable for its safety.
6. **NO alcohol to be consumed or stored on any float at any time.**
7. Reasonable precautions must be made to ensure any fire risk to the float or occupants is negated, where possible using fire proof /resistant fabrics and building materials. Every float must have AT LEAST one appropriate fire extinguisher which must to be shown to our safety marshal before the procession begins.
8. The driver of each float must have access to the appropriate fire extinguishers and should be fully aware of and be familiar with the route. The driver should travel the route before carnival day.
9. Each driver will be briefed on the day with details of the route, regulations and safety notes for use during the procession. A signed declaration will be required from each driver on the day stating that they are entitled by law to drive the class of vehicle and have relevant insurance. They will also be required to provide their contact details.
10. The use of generators is advised against, but often necessary. Where possible these should be in an isolated area, secure and contain sufficient fuel for the duration of the event.  
No additional fuel is to be carried on the float.  
There must be NO attempt to refuel whilst the generator is hot or after the procession has left the start point.
11. Any electrical installations on any float must be correctly installed, with relevant safety switch-gear installed, where possible using low voltage and avoiding the use of conventional glass bulbs.
12. Due to the terms imposed on us by our street collection licence, you are only permitted to collect donations for Melksham Carnival Funds while in the procession. You are NOT permitted to collect donations for ANY other cause

**Each float will be inspected for safety before the procession begins.**

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THESE REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE CARNIVAL EITHER TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY.**
