Applications for spaces for the Family Fun Day may not be accepted after **MONDAY 23rd July 2018***.

Stall holders will NOT be admitted before 10.30 AM* and must be ready to receive customers from 12 noon onwards. We ask that you vacate before 5 PM* to enable everyone to watch the parade.

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY TO FAMILY FUN DAY

OWNERS & ORGANISERS & ATTENDANTS OF STALLS & ATTRACTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO NOTE, ACCEPT AND ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING;

1. Space is allocated and charged for in multiples of the single pitch size of 4m x 3m*
The pitches will be FREE plus a raffle prize or voucher for charities and other nonprofit organisations, £40.00* plus a raffle prize or voucher for businesses and £15.00 for hobbyists and Crafters (*except by prior agreement)
2. Please ensure all persons in your group follow ANY instruction/advice provided by the stewards at any time.
3. NO alcohol to be sold or stored on any stall at any time.
4. If gas is necessarily used it must be by prior agreement with Melksham Carnival and all associated equipment must carry the relevant safety and testing certificates
5. Reasonable precautions must be made to ensure any fire risk to the stall or occupants is negated, where possible. It is advised that every stall should have one appropriate fire extinguisher.
6. In the case of gas, electrical generators or naked flames being used an appropriate fire extinguisher MUST be available. All persons on these stalls must have access to appropriate fire extinguishers and should be fully aware of and familiar with their correct use.
7. Where generators are necessary they should be in an isolated area, secure and contain sufficient fuel for the duration of the event. If additional fuel is required it should be stored in a safe and secure location in PLASTIC containers complying with SI 1982/630.
No attempt to refuel must be made whilst the generator is hot.
8. Any electrical installations on any stall must be correctly installed, with relevant safety switch-gear installed, where possible using low voltage and avoiding the use of conventional glass bulbs. All electrical equipment must be covered by a current PAT test certificate

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THESE REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE EVENT EITHER TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY.
